Sociable Seniors' Morning Out in Kilkivan

Despite the restrictions imposed in the Covid-19 era, a small but happy gathering marked the first session of a Seniors' Social Hub at the Supper Room of the Kilkivan Community Hall complex on Wednesday morning.

Organised by members of the Kilkivan & District Community Care Assn Inc. to encourage social networking, the gathering of mainly Kilkivan residents heard from Nurse Practitioner Jenny Doherty who explained her role as part of the suite of health services now on offer at Kilkivan's Health Clinic. Then Goomeri resident Jan Ferguson demonstrated some simple art techniques to produce a designer coaster in under ten minutes. She then encouraged others to try their hand.

Key organiser Robert Thompson said later that he was very pleased with how the session had gone and looks forward to having even more attendees at the next session on Wednesday, September 2.
